Ladakh, Aug 11; Ladakh has scrapped the Inner Line Permit (ILP) system, which will benefit Indian tourists visiting the 'protected' areas in the region as there will be less paperwork required to deal with.

However, tourists visiting these areas will still have to pay the environmental fee of Rs 300 and Red Cross Fund fee of Rs 100. The payment

can be easily made using the online portal, officials said.

The report added that all visitors are required to carry identity proof during travel and foreigners are still required the Protected Area Permit. Earlier, Indian tourists were only allowed to visit areas beyond Panamik till Warshi including Yarma Gompa/Yarma Gonbo Monastery in Leh's Nubra Valley.



Ladakh was opened up for tourists in October 1974. Although tourists were allowed to travel to a limited number

of places. Access to tourist spots like Pangong Tso was restricted as it was accessible only between 6am and 5 pm.

Melbourne extends lockdown, Sydney turns safe

Canberra, Aug 11:

Australia's second-largest city, Melbourne, extended its lockdown today in a bid to stamp out an outbreak of COVID-19, while authorities in Sydney said they were considering easing restrictions for vaccinated residents despite the delta variant continuing to spread.

Most Australians have to request an exemption from an international travel ban to leave the country. Thousands have missed weddings, funerals and opportunities to meet newborn relatives since the widely criticized ban began in March last year.

Check fares on airline's website: DGCA

New Delhi, Aug 11:

Aviation regulator DGCA on Tuesday advised passengers planning to travel to international destinations to check ticket prices on the website of the airline concerned as metasearch engines at times do not reflect the actual point to point fare.

Various metasearch engine websites such as Google and Skyscanner operate in India.

The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) said on Twitter that metasearch engines at times do make combinations of multiple airlines - when a passenger is looking for a point to point travel - and end up with an exaggerated figure of airfare. Last Saturday, Sanjeev Gupta, Secretary, Inter-State Council Secretariat, Union Home Ministry, had complained on Twitter that an economy-class ticket on British Airways's Delhi-London flight for August 26 was priced at Rs 3.95 lakh.

However, the Ministry of Civil Aviation clarified on Sunday that an economy-class ticket on Delhi-London flight has been available for between Rs 1.03 lakh and Rs 1.47 lakh during August.

QR passes at 65 railway stations in Mumbai



Mumbai, Aug 11: Arrangements will be made at 65 railway stations in Mumbai, where quick response or QR code-based passes will be issued to people who have taken both doses of COVID-19 vaccine and wish to travel in suburban local trains, city mayor Kishori Pednekar said on Tuesday.

Maharashtra Chief Minister Uddhav Thackeray had announced that fully vaccinated citizens can travel in local trains from August 15, but a gap of 14 days from the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine is necessary to avail the facility.

Speaking to reporters here, the mayor said, "Citizens should not indulge in altercations, as long queues are likely at ticket counters. People should cooperate and follow the COVID-19 norms."

Pednekar further said that arrangements are being made to issue QR code-based passes to passengers at 65 railway stations that come under the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation's (BMC) jurisdiction.

The state government had restricted local train travel to government employees and people employed in essential service staffs, since April 2021, to control the COVID-19 spread during the second wave.
